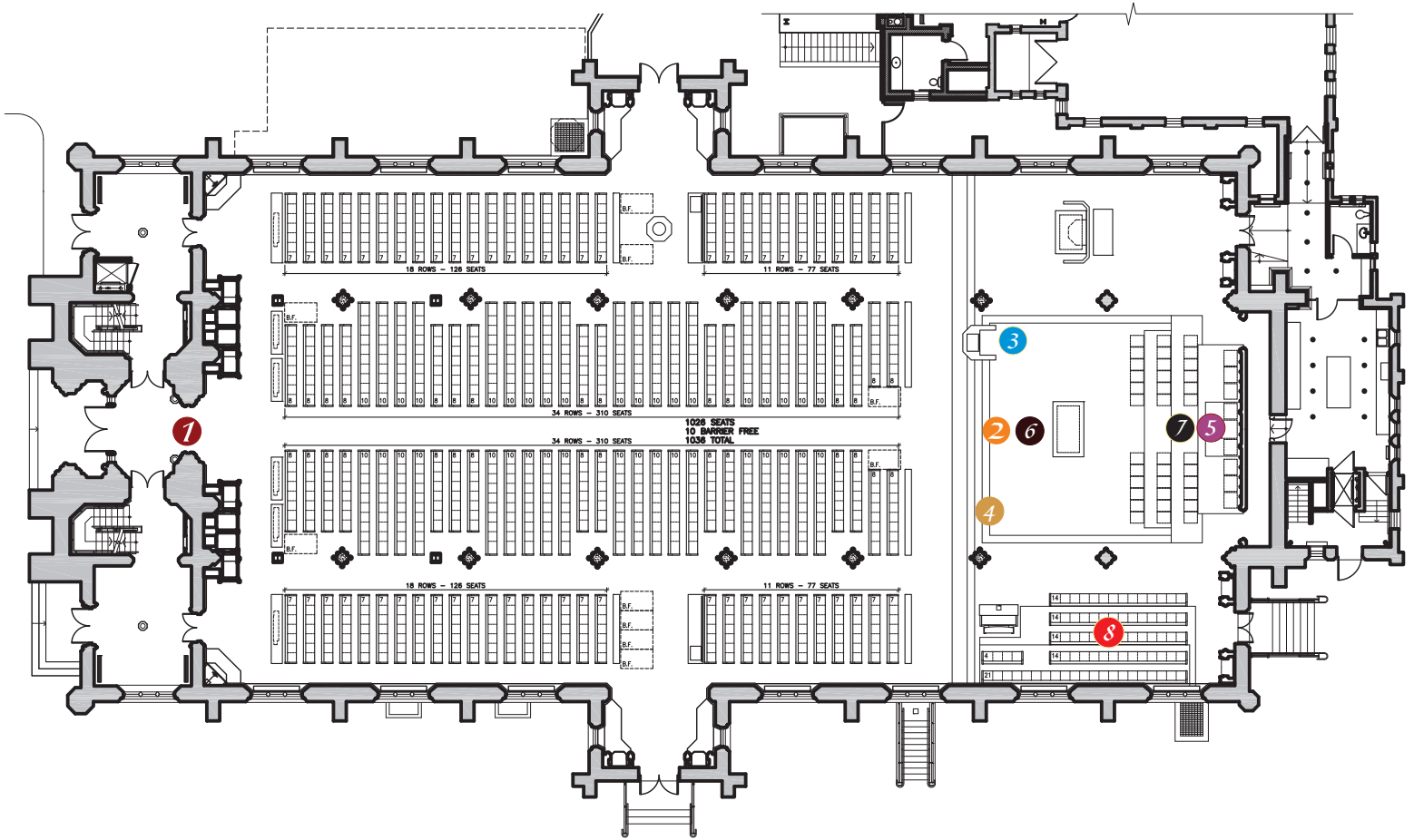




# The Order of the Service

Understanding the Mass of Installation.



- 1** Archbishop-Designate Leo is met at the doors of the Cathedral and greeted by Reverend Frank Portelli, Rector of the Cathedral, who presents him with a crucifix for veneration.  
Then Archbishop-Designate Leo blesses himself and those present with holy water.
- 2** Sign of the Cross and Greeting by The Most Reverend Ivan Jurkovic, Apostolic Nuncio to Canada
- 3** Reading of the Apostolic Mandate by Msgr. Antons Prikulis, First Secretary of the Apostolic Nunciature in Canada reads the apostolic Letter from His Holiness Pope Francis, appointing The Most Reverend Francis Leo as the Archbishop of Toronto.  
The Apostolic Nuncio asks the Archbishop-Designate if he is willing to accept the Metropolitan See of Toronto.
- 4** Fr. Edward Curtis, chancellor, shows the Apostolic Mandate to the College of Consultors for inspection, and then to the people.
- 5** Archbishop Leo is led to the cathedra by Archbishop Jurkovic and Cardinal Collins. He is seated and presented with his crosier, the sign of his pastoral office, as the Archbishop of Toronto.
- 6** Archbishop Leo is greeted by members of the local clergy, religious and representatives of the Catholic faithful who will offer a sign of reverence and a word of welcome.
- 7** Archbishop Leo gives his first homily as Archbishop of Toronto.
- 8** Music by St. Michael's Choir School, founded in 1937 to facilitate training of a boy's choir for St. Michael's Cathedral.

- Archbishop Leo is the 11th Archbishop since Toronto was made an Archdiocese in 1870.
- There will be **62** Bishops and **2** Cardinals in the sanctuary (altar area) celebrating the installation of Archbishop Leo.
- The Toronto Archdiocese is the largest English Diocese in Canada with **225** parishes and **1.9** million Catholics.
